About One Youth

One Youth is an initiative by One Corporation which aims to improve literacy rate in rural communities of Nepal by easing the access to educational resources to needy children and villages. Till date, more than 36 schools and 9000 children have been benefitted with this initiative. The primary objective of the project is to build computer labs, setup libraries, science lab while supporting children with bags, copies, books, uniform, clothes and other resources vital to a formal education.

About Bajura

Bajura District, a part of Sudur Pashchim Province, is one of the seventy-seven districts of Nepal. The district, with Martadi today part of Badimalika municipality as its district headquarters.

Geographically the district is divided in three distinct regions from north to south. Higher Himalayan Region, Higher Mountain and mid Mountains. At the time of the 2011 Nepal census, Bajura District had a population of 134,912. Of these, 99.0% spoke Nepali and 0.5% Sherpa as their first language.

The small health centers in many VDCs are without Auxiliary Health Workers (AHWs), Auxiliary Nurse Midwives (ANMs) and Community Health Workers (CHWs). Primary or normal treatment can be done in the district headquarters and also in Bayalpata Hospital of neighboring district Accham while people seeking severe cases have to travel a long distance to Kathmandu or other major cities or end up dying because of lack of treatment.

Poverty Rate in Bajura


About 71 percent of the households in Bajura district are living below the poverty line and have low social indicators in areas such as health and education besides lacking market access. Among the 13,619 households out of the 21,711 households in the district that have been classified as 'poor'. Within that group, 6,393 households have been identified as 'extreme poor'. According to a survey conducted by the secretariat in 25 districts to distribute poor identity cards, 4,228 households among the total poor households are 'mid-poor' while 2,998 are 'general poor'.

In terms of the number of households, Kailali district has 21,577 households under the poverty line, the largest among the districts surveyed.

The poor households are eligible for government social security programs including educational scholarship, health insurance and skill training towards food security and self-employment.


Education Status in Bajura



Education Level Passed by Sex



Our Objectives in Bajura

By easing access to modern educational resources, our aim is to increase the literacy rate throughout the country, one child at a time. To achieve that goal, we have been organizing projects in the rural part of Nepal to help those who are deprived of basic equipment's for quality education.

This time our objective is to provide 510 children of 10 schools in rural Gaumul Municipality, Bajura, with basic necessities like bags, pen, pencils, exercise books as well as school dress, shoes, socks, sweater, tie, belt, etc. We will also be setting up a couple of libraries in the village.

This will be our fourth time visiting the region. Previously we've setup 3 libraries, 3 computer labs and provided 600 children with educational resources.

We also plan to teach basic filmmaking to the students by extending our village stay by a week.
