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1. ABOUT ONE Youth

ONE Youth is a registered nonprofit organization (Reg no. 205) in Nepal. It is also a member of Social Welfare Council with a registration number 42194. The major sector of workings since 2015 are education, health, leadership and environment, incorporated within an individual project "Education Infrastructure Development."

2. About Education Infrastructure Development

Education Infrastructure Development is a collaborative project that combines every sector within ONE Youth. The project is targeted for rural government schools within Nepal. The tasks can be classified with their own distinctive features and a separate team.

2.1 MAJOR TASKS

- A sustainable computer lab with at least 3 computers.
- A library with a minimum of 1000 textual and nontextual books.

- Stationary donation (bags, copies, pens).
- Drug Abuse Prevention lectures.
- Sexuality and Reproductive Health Education.

3. OBJECTIVES

During our projects, we have been to schools and know students who have not yet seen a single computer. We believe that a key to development is a qualitative education which is impossible without computer education. Lack of computer education, students will not be able to study in the competitive environment and neither get a proper job to get along with their life. Their ultimate solution is to go abroad and work with minimum wages possible.

In a poor nation like Nepal, rural families depend upon agriculture for food and money. Poverty discourages the guardians to send their children to school as sending their children requires stationery, lunch and other resources. So, they take their children to work along the fields with them. Stationery Donations and scholarship to those needy helps to eradicate this problem.

Education Infrastructure Development, thus, aims to improve quality of life through quality education i.e. a proper library and a computer lab which will make students competitive so that local manpower can be utilized for nation's development.


